

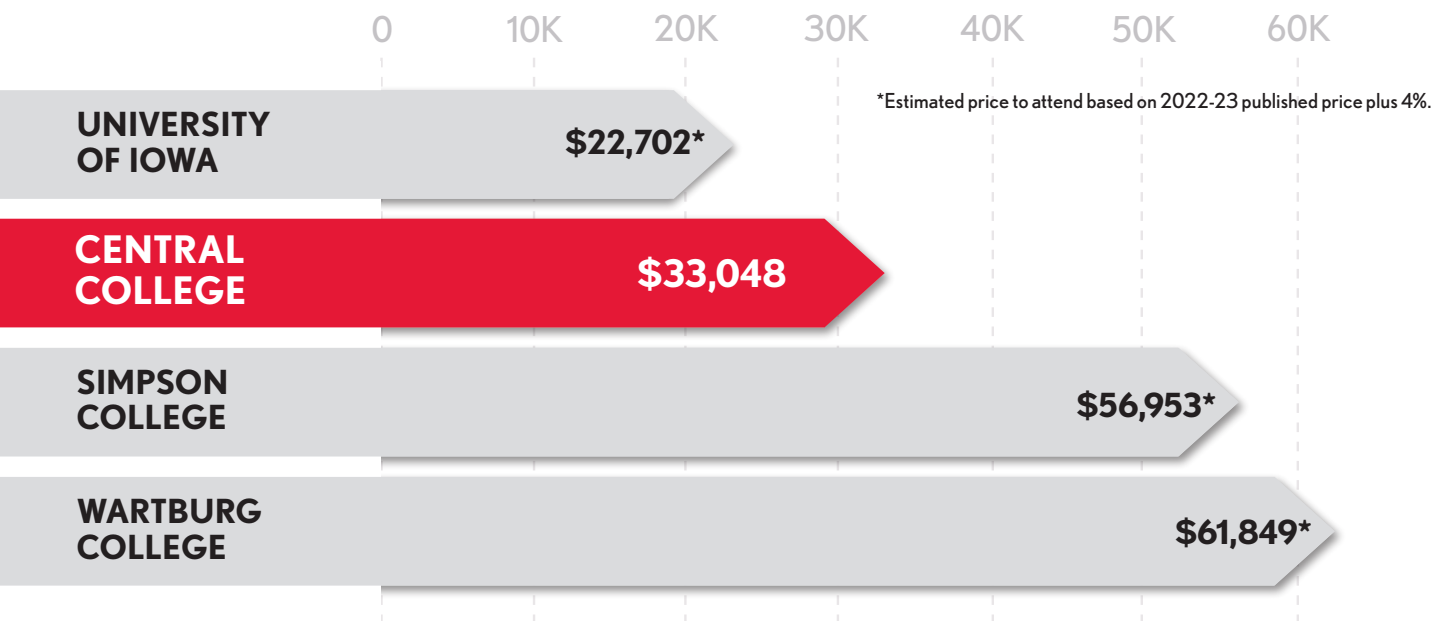

SCHOLARSHIPS	CRITERIA	AMOUNT
Presidential Transfer Scholarship*	Awarded to students who have achieved a 3.5 cumulative college GPA AND completed at least 26 semester hours of college work.	\$5,000
Distinguished Transfer Scholarship*	Awarded to students who have achieved a 3.0 cumulative college GPA.	\$3,000
Central Transfer Scholarship*	Awarded to students who have graduated from high school AND have enrolled in and completed college coursework.	up to \$1,000
Journey Scholarship	EVERY admitted student receives a Journey Scholarship, made possible by generous donors.	\$1,000
Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship	Awarded to students who are active members of Phi Theta Kappa. Awarded in addition to any merit-based scholarship.	\$1,000
Heritage Award	Available to students who are members of the Reformed Church in America OR the child of an alum OR have a sibling who is a Central alum or current student.	\$500
Scholar Days	Scholar Days give students an opportunity to earn top academic scholarships up to full tuition. This event is exclusively offered to admitted students.	\$500–\$1,500

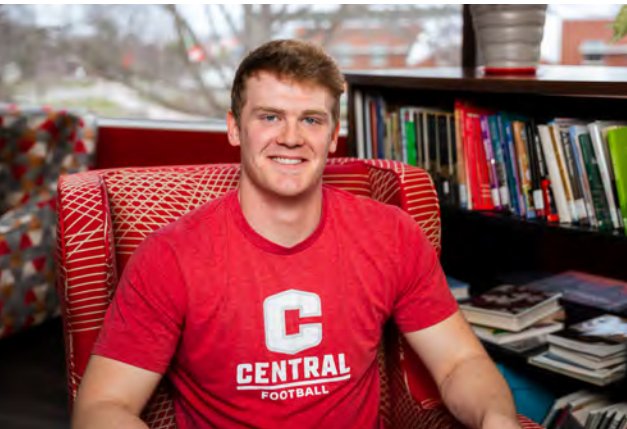
